## Update on Dissolution of CSA 70/W-1 and Annexation to BDVWA

General Manager West reported the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) voted in favor of the annexation proposal. The thirty day reconsideration period will end in February after which the protest ballots will be mailed to property owners and registered voters. West reminded the Board that during the process so far there has been zero opposition. West also explained the protest ballot process and its timeline.

Once the protest ballot is complete the Agency will move forward with the conversion of customer information from County Special Districts to Bighorn-Desert View Water Agency. Also, per the pending protest ballot, the Agency will increase the field staff by two employees. Both of these actions will not begin until after the protest hearing.
