Prop. 1 Planning Grant for Water System Integration and Interties Update

General Manager West gave a brief update on the Prop. 1 Planning Grant. The Agency submitted a package for up to \$6,000,000.00 in improvements for the Agency but the Prop.1 Grant Ranking System has given the Agency a low ranking. General Manager West explained that since this package was denied, the Agency is going to focus on the Goat Mountain area and how much well capacity it has available. Also, if that capacity is able to provide the maximum day demand. If not, the Agency will be able to get a higher ranking for funding approval. In the meantime, the Agency will use the planning grant money it received to proceed with the planning activities: Property acquisition, CEQA and NEPA. This would prepare the Agency should funding be made available. Another funding source that the Agency has been waiting on is the Colorado Regional Water Quality Control Boards Disadvantage Community Grant. The Agency was slated for \$50,000.00 to study uranium. General Manager West explained that the lab that does the testing for the uranium had recently changed methods. Due to this change in testing, the Agency's uranium values are now under the State maximum allowable uranium level of 20 Pico Curies/Liter (pCi/L). Vice President Corl-Lorono asked if the Agency is able to turn Well 4 back online. General Manager West said that it is a possibility if we can demonstrate a 4 quarter average below 20pCi/L.
